

There has been some confusion regarding the worship opportunity at the drive-in, including whether or not it will happen. Yes, there will be worship at the drive-in. Hopefully the info below will clarify things, but if you still have questions please don't hesitate to ask. Sorry for the length, but I think it will answer most, if not all of your questions if you read it through to the end.

The following (in blue) is the information which Pastor Cunningham passed along to me a few minutes ago.

Worship at Melody Drive In will take place beginning this Sunday, March 22nd. Service begins at 9:00 a.m. and heard through your FM radio at 89.3. In order to observe Social Distancing as much as possible, there will be no service folder handed out and no offering gathered. A brief order of service may be offered online through the Melody Drive In website and Facebook page so check there before you leave home.

Sunday service information, readings and recordings can also be found on St. Peter's website and through Facebook. Other resources to aid your spiritual care and needs are posted there as well. Blessings to all as we remain the Body of Christ, serving our neighbor.

If you plan to attend please read and follow these rules posted by Melody Drive-In on their Facebook page (in red).

As stated in our earlier post we will do our part in keeping our community strong and nothing is more important through times like this than being able to express your freedom to worship, over the last few decades or so we have been proud to partner with the Bass Lake Ministry group in providing a worship service for the community.

Under the current situation, the Bass Lake Worship services will start early this year and begin this Sunday, March 22 at 9 am central time at the Melody Drive-In. This will allow Christians to continue to attend worship while in the comfort and safety and also isolation of their own vehicles. The worship service is generally only 30 to 45 minutes in length. With that being said, to help prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus, we ask that people who plan on attending that they adhere to the following guidelines.

1. Allow some space between parked cars. Allowing only one car per spot between poles

2. The outdoor Speakers will be disable for the duration of the service. To hear the service you will have to use the car radio only, tune to 89.3fm

3. DO NOT get out of your car for any reason.

4. Please bring your beverages or food with you as all of the concession facilities will not be open.

5. The use of restroom facilities will be prohibited as the public bathrooms will not be open.
